David Wang was named vice president of The Boeing Company and president of Boeing China in November 2002.

Currently Wang also serves as the co-chairman of the US-China Aviation Cooperation Program (ACP), the US-China Energy Cooperation Program (ECP) and the Export Compliance Working Group (ECWG) at AmCham. Both ECP and ECWG are collaborative programs between AmCham China and AmCham Shanghai.



Wang also serves on the Board of Directors of two publicly listed companies in the US. He also serves on a number of charitable boards, including Junior Achievement China and various university advisory bodies.

Prior to joining Boeing, Wang served as chairman and chief executive officer of General Electric (GE) China for 5 years. Prior to this, he held leadership positions with GE in Malaysia/ Singapore, Mexico, and the U.S. He started GE first China joint venture in China and has had numerous operating and corporate roles with GE over a 22 year GE career.

Wang holds a BS degree in Electrical Engineering from St Louis University, and both an MSEE and a honorary professional degree from the Missouri University of Science and Technology.
