

Tina Ju is the founding and Managing Partner of KPCB China. She is also the founding and Managing Partner of TDF Capital.

Tina brings a combined 20 years of experience in venture capital, investment banking and operation. She joined VTDF in 1999 as Managing Director of VTDF China Fund, and founded TDF Capital China in 2005. In April 2007, the US\$360 million KPCB China Fund was launched to back Chinese entrepreneurs and to promote innovation in high-growth industries in China.

Tina's focus areas of investment include TMT, greentech and consumer services. Since 2000, she has been involved in 20⁺ investments, including Alibaba, Focus Media, Baidu, and Hurray. Her board participation includes Alibaba, Hurray, Huizhong, Yicha, DHgate, etc.

Prior to venture capital, Tina served as the CFO/COO for PrivyLink, a portfolio company of TDF. She spent 11 years in investment banking at Deutsche Bank (Head of TMT and Transport Asia), Merrill Lynch and Goldman Sachs.

Tina has been awarded the Top Ten Active Venture Capitalist award by Zero2IPO in 2005, and was named as China's Best Venture Capitalist by Forbes China in 2006 and 2007. Tina is the chairperson of WIL (Women in Leadership) in China.
